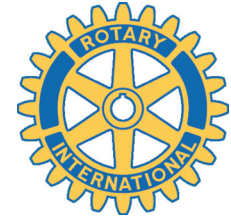




Todmorden Boundary Walk 22 miles
Todmorden Pike Hike 12 miles
Todmorden Boundary Run 22 miles
All Sunday 26th May 2019



All proceeds in aid of Rotary Charities

All three events start and finish at the Bellhome sports park (on the Todmorden-Rochdale road). Limited car parking is available at Bellhome for a fee of £2 per car by reservation, and then first come first served.

The 22 mile route of the Boundary Walk & Run takes in parts of both the Calderdale Way and the Pennine Way and follows the old Todmorden Borough boundary. The 12 mile Pike Hike follows the canal towpath to Eastwood before joining the final Boundary Walk section up to Stoodley Pike. All routes are flagged and have radio controlled checkpoints. All checkpoints will have water and light refreshments available as well as transport back to the start for anyone not able to continue for whatever reason.

Please mark clearly on your entry form which event you wish to enter.

The entry fee for the Boundary Walk and Boundary Run is £12 per person, £9 for those under 16 years. Entry for the Pike Hike is £10 and £8 respectively. **A discount of £2 per person should be deducted from all entries received before the day of the event.**

Cheques for all events should be made payable to Todmorden Rotary Club.

Conditions for all entrants

Your signature on the Entry Form will be deemed as acceptance of the following conditions, and any advice given on the day of the event by the Organisers and the Rescue Services, and that you agree that no liability is accepted by the Organisers for any injury, loss or damage sustained during the event.

1. NO DOGS are allowed on the Boundary Walk(Rescue dogs excepted) but DOGS ARE allowed on the "Pike Hike". Guide lines for looking after dogs will be posted clearly at registration and should be adhered to.
2. The minimum age limit is 10 years of age and Children aged 10 to 14 years must be accompanied by a parent/guardian in a maximum ratio one Parent /Guardian to two children.
3. Young people aged 15 to 18 years will only be allowed by permission of their parent/guardian and a signature of the parent/guardian is required on the entry form.
4. Walkers should wear suitable clothing and footwear for the open moorland conditions which will be encountered and should consider carrying spare clothing.
5. Participants should respect farm property and keep to the marked route which has been agreed with landowners.
6. Participants should honour The Country Code by fastening farm gates, not lighting fires, leaving livestock, farm machinery and crops alone, take litter home and protecting wildlife, plants and trees.
7. Participants who wish to drop out part way through the walk should do so at a Check Point and hand in their tab to an official at the Check Point so they can be accounted for.
8. Advice given by Walk Marshals and Rescue Services Personnel should be accepted.
9. Participants enter at their own risk and they should make their own personal accident insurance arrangements.
10. The Organisers reserve the right to amend the route or cancel the event at short notice, eg if the weather poses an unacceptable risk. In such circumstances it is regretted that entry fees cannot be refunded.
11. **Registration on the day is at Bellholme between 8.00am and 9.15am for the Boundary Walk and 9.00am and 10.00am for the "Pike Hike". 9.15am to 10.00am for the Boundary Run.**

Complete the Entry Form (one for each entrant) and return it with the entrance fee (including car park fee if required) together with a C5 stamped addressed envelope (160mmx230mm) for your receipt brochure, to:
